Sir Graham Thornicroft is Professor of Community Psychiatry at the Institute of Psychiatry, Psychology and Neuroscience, King's College London (KCL).

He has made significant contributions to the development of mental health policy in England and in global mental health. His areas of research expertise include: stigma and discrimination, mental health needs assessment, cost-effectiveness evaluations of mental health treatments, service user led research, implementation science, and global mental health. Graham has authored or edited 30 books and over 469 peer-reviewed papers in Pubmed.

Sir Graham Thornicroft est professeur de psychiatrie communautaire à l'Institut de psychiatrie, de psychologie et de neuroscience du King's College de Londres (KCL). Il a contribué de manière significative au développement de la politique de santé mentale en Angleterre et dans le monde.
